That's exactly what's going on at Browns in South Molton Street between now and Christmas. Founder of *Jalouse* magazine, Thomas Erber, who collaborated on publications such as Vogue Hommes, Citizen K. and Rolling Stone and works as an 'international brand consultant', has created a 'Cabinet de Curiosités'.

Erber has invited 31 designers to create something properly special that best shows off the breadth and depth of their creative wares. The designers include Manolo Blahnik, iWoodesign, and travel company Kuoni. For Erber's cabinet, Kuoni has designed two individual, luxurious and very tempting journeys; a romantic road trip along the coast of Uruguay and a family adventure in Namibia.

Other curiosities include a 'chair trunk' by Pinel & Pinel, mink lined boots by Pierre Hardy and a ruby and diamond pendant by House of Waris, which are all dotted around Browns and everyone of them is for sale. I know which one I'd like... (Uruguay please?)
