Maison Kitsuné Makes Exclusive Flight Jacket For Le Cabinet de Curiosités of Thomas Erber



Since 2010, Thomas Erber has been rounding up the most talented designers and best brands to create special pieces exhibited at his <u>Le Cabinet de Curiosités of Thomas Erber</u> showcases. His first was in Paris at colette in 2010, followed by Browns in London in 2011, and then last year he chose Berlin's Andreas Murkudis. In 2013, Erber comes to New York, setting up at the Nomad Hotel's Maison Kitsuné boutique, and NoLIta's Avant/Garde Diaries Project Space.

Culling 50 brands and artists to collaborate on limited-edition pieces, one of the easy standouts is this blacked-out, sheepskin-lined leather jacket from Maison Kitsuné. Limited to just two pieces, it's the kind of clothing item that doubles as a work of art. See it up close at the exhibition.
